

Anti-meth poster contest deadline nears

PHOENIX — Attorney General Terry Goddard reminds Arizona middle school students that time is running out for participation in the 2010 Arizona Meth Project's "Not Even Once" poster contest.

The effort is designed to raise awareness of the dangers of methamphetamine. Arizona seventh- and eighth-graders are eligible to enter. This is the first year the contest is being extended to include seventh-graders. Submissions must be received by 5 p.m. Jan. 29.

Contest results will be announced in February. Contest winners will receive first-, second- and third-place prizes of \$500, \$350 and \$100. Winning submissions will be printed on a full-size poster and used throughout 2010 in the Arizona Meth Project's statewide public awareness campaign.
